Application for Drain Layer / Plumber License

The undersigned hereby applies for a Drain Layer / Plumber License (License) from Southwest Metropolitan Water and Sanitation District.

In applying for a License, the contractor acknowledges and agrees to the following:

- 1. Contractor agrees to maintain the following minimum insurance coverages during the term of the License:
 - (a) <u>Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance</u>. Contractor shall carry Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance to cover liabilities under the laws of the State of Colorado.
 - (b) <u>Commercial General Liability Insurance</u>. Contractor shall carry Commercial General Liability Insurance, which shall include blanket contractual liability coverage. Such insurance shall be in the amount of \$350,000 for each occurrence and \$1,000,000 general aggregate in combined single limit coverage for bodily injury and property damage.

The required Commercial General Liability policy shall (i) name the District as an additional insured for coverage only, with no premium payment obligation; and (ii) provide that the coverage for the district shall not be impaired by Contractor's or any subcontractors' failure to comply with any of the terms or conditions of the policy. Contractor shall provide Certificates of Insurance (and renewals thereof) demonstrating that the required coverages for Commercial General Liability and Worker's Compensation Insurance have been obtained.

- 2. Contractor agrees to submit a Corporate Surety Bond in the amount of not less than \$10,000 in favor of the District for the faithful performance and observance of the District's rules and regulations and for the protection of the District in the event the contractor causes injury or damage to any District facility including but not limited to any tap on a District's sanitary sewer main.
- 3. Contractor agrees to pay a License processing fee of \$100.00.
- 4. Contractor agrees to provide at least 24 hours notice to the District in advance of any work conducted on or within five feet of a District sewer main. Notice is to be given by calling 303-979-2333.
- 5. Contractor agrees to obtain an inspection and acceptance of the work done on a District sewer main prior to backfilling the excavation or completion of pipe lining.
- 6. Contractor agrees to pay inspection fees as specified in the License.
